


6 Books About 2SLGBTQ+ Relationships

1. Two Grooms on a Cake: The Story of America's First Gay Wedding (7+):

By Author Rob Sanders Illustrated by Robbie Cathro

Based on the true story of Jack Baker and Michael McConnell, this book takes the perspective of two wedding groom cake toppers as they discuss the story of Jack and Michael, and how they strove for marriage equity in Minnesota.






2. Prince and Knight (4+): By Daniel Haack, Illustrated by Stevie Lewis

This book takes a more modern approach to fairy tales, as we follow a prince who is in search of his true love. While away a dragon attacks the kingdom, and as the prince fights the dragon with a brave knight he discovers that this knight was the person he was looking for all along.

3. Love Violet (+6): By Charlotte Sullivan Wild, Illustrated by Charlene Chua

This story follows a young boy who has learned of serenata traditions from his father, and asks him if there are any serenatas for boys who love boys.

5. Worm Loves Worm (4+): By J.J. Austrian. Illustrated by Mike Curato

This Story Follows Worm and Worm, two worms who wish to marry each other. As they get ready, many other insects begin to add to the wedding, saying they need a cake, bridesmaid, gown, suit, etc. as the story progresses the worms begin to change the wedding traditions to best suit their needs, as they discover that their love for each other is the most important part of a wedding.
